筆者要做的是從歷史著作出發,以南京大屠殺的相關著作為探討對象,從中了解歷史的書寫是一個區分歷史與歷史事件的敘事,並探討歷史事件的時間軸,即為事件時間。並進依不討論敘事的基礎:在場者。最後,作者將以觀察所得現象,從社會學的觀點進行反思。
